## **Equal Opportunities and Inclusion policy**

- 1. The Equal Opportunities and Inclusion Policy for Forest School works alongside the Equal Opportunities and Inclusion Policy for Newick CE Primary School.
- 2. Forest School sessions are to be inclusive for all children, parents, helpers and staff regardless of gender, culture, language, learning needs, sexual orientation, socio-economic status or ability.
- 3. Support will be given to children, parents, helpers and staff where working within the natural environment is not normal for them and makes them feel uncomfortable.
- 4. Clothing or equipment will be provided for those children or adults that cannot afford to provide it.
- 5. Learning tasks will be adapted to simplify or challenge pupils as necessary as well as to suit different learning styles and multiple intelligences.
- 6. Visual signs or timetables will be used for pupils that find transitions difficult or who have communication and language difficulties.
- 7. Adult support will be given to pupils who have mobility difficulties so that they can access the Forest School site.
- 8. Parents, carers and helpers will be actively encouraged to come to Forest School sessions.
- 9. All pupils and adults will be encouraged to feel secure and know that their contributions are valued.
- 10. Pupils will be encouraged to take responsibility for their behaviour and support each other in resolving conflicts.
- 11. Pupils and adults will be encouraged to work collaboratively so that friendships can be fostered.
