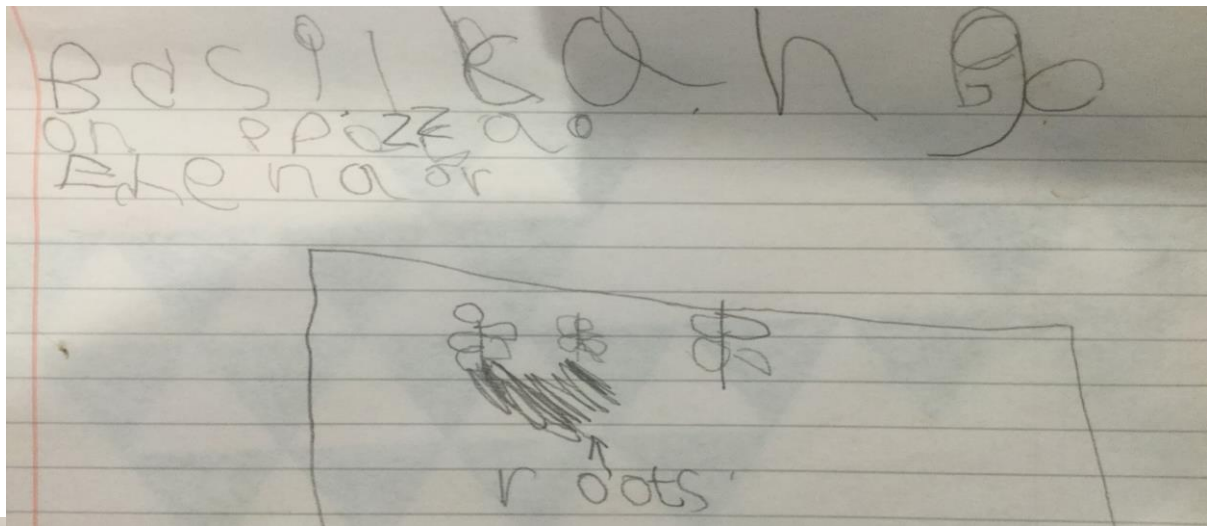
Week 2 14.09.21

we wrote:	What we had learned from this session.


We also built two raised bed for the

we wrote:	what we had learned from this session.

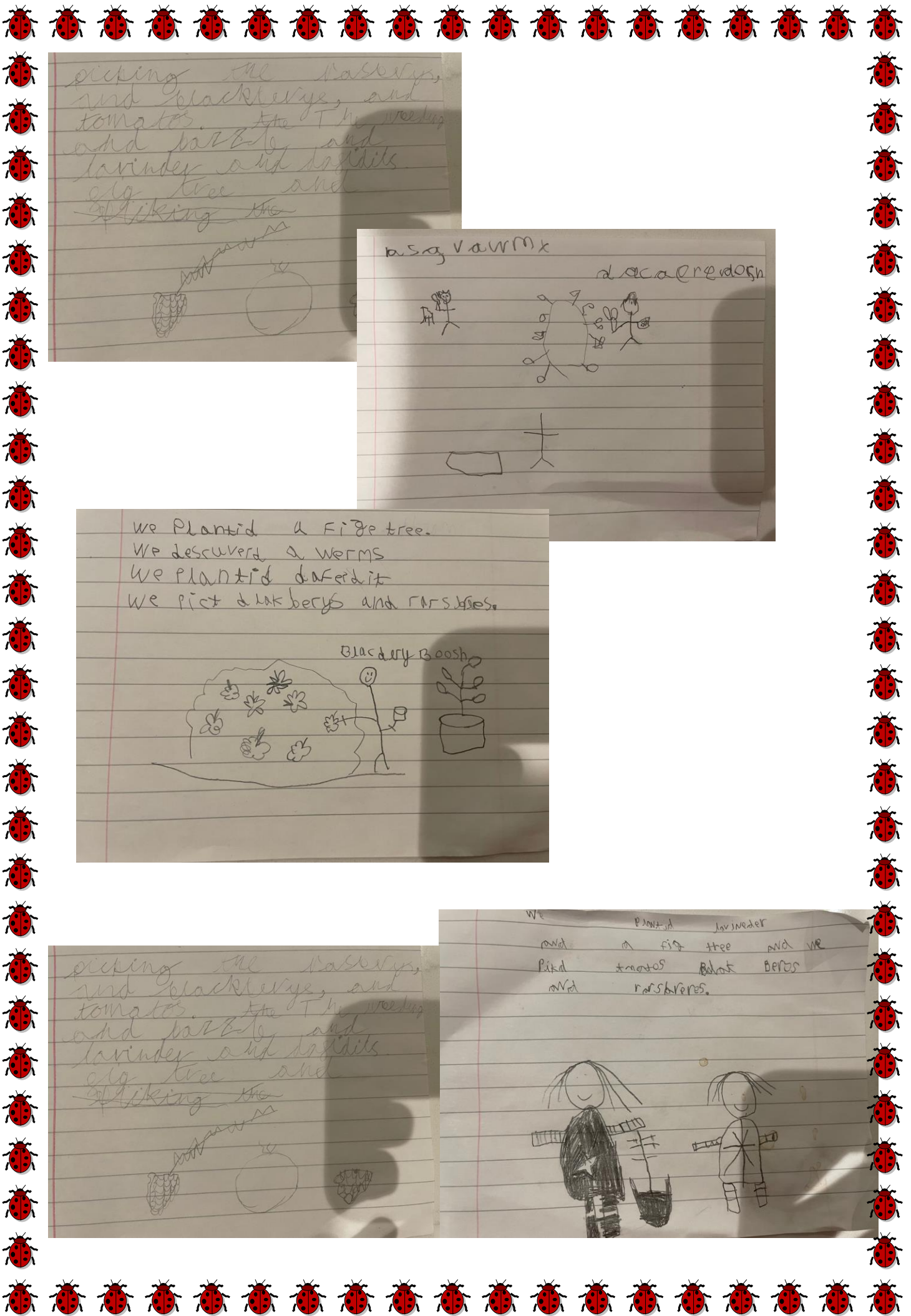
